



Finding Your Place: Teaching

Romans 12:5-7 (NIV) so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. **6** We have different gifts, according to the grace given us. If a man's gift... is teaching, let him teach;

1. We are all teachers

Deuteronomy 11:18-21 (NIV) Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. **(19)** Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. **(20)** Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates, **(21)** so that your days and the days of your children may be many in the land that the LORD swore to give your forefathers, as many as the days that the heavens are above the earth.

Titus 2:7-8a (GW) Always set an example by doing good things. When you teach, be an example of moral purity and dignity. **(8)** Speak an accurate message that cannot be condemned.

James 3:1-2 (MSG) Don't be in any rush to become a teacher, my friends. Teaching is highly responsible work. Teachers are held to the strictest standards. **2** And none of us is perfectly qualified. We get it wrong nearly every time we open our mouths. If you could find someone whose speech was perfectly true, you'd have a perfect person, in perfect control of life.

2. What are we to teach?

1 Timothy 4:8-12 (NIV) For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come. **(9)** This is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance **(10)** (and for this we labor and strive), that we have put our hope in the living God, who is the Savior of all men, and especially of those who believe. **(11)** Command and teach these things. **(12)** Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity.

Psalms 90:12 (GW) Teach us to number each of our days so that we may grow in wisdom.

Job 6:24 (GW)... Show me where I've been wrong.

1 Timothy 4:16 (NIV) Watch your life and doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because if you do, you will save both yourself and your hearers.

3. Who are we to teach?

☆ **Children-** *Deuteronomy 11:19 (NIV)* "Teach them to your children"

☆ **Each other-** *Colossians 3:16 (NLT)* Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives.

☆ **Ourselves-** *Romans 2:21 (ESV)* ...you then who teach others, do you not teach yourself?

☆ **Even a wise person-** *Proverbs 9:9 (NIV)* Instruct a wise man and he will be wiser still; teach a righteous man and he will add to his learning.
