



DO YOU HAVE ROOM?

John 1:10-12 (NASB) (10) He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. **(11)** He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him. **(12)** But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, *even* to those who believe in His name,

Isaiah 9:6 (NASB) (6) For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

Isaiah 7:14 (NASB) (14) Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel.

John 3:16-18 (ESV) (16) “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷ For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. ¹⁸ Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

Ephesians 2:4-5 (NLT) (4) But God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much, ⁵ that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God’s grace that you have been saved!)

2 Corinthians 5:21 (NASB) (21) He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Romans 3:21-22 (NASB) (21) But now apart from the Law *the* righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, **(22)** *even the* righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction;

2 Corinthians 1:21-22 (NLT) (21) It is God who enables us, along with you, to stand firm for Christ. He has commissioned us, **(22)** and he has identified us as his own by placing the Holy Spirit in our hearts as the first installment that guarantees everything he has promised us.

Romans 5:10 (NASB) (10) For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

John 14:19b-20 NASB) (19b) because I live, you will live also. **(20)** In that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

2 Kings 5:13 (NASB) (13) Then his servants came near and spoke to him and said, “My father, had the prophet told you *to do some* great thing, would you not have done *it*? How much more *then*, when he says to you, ‘Wash, and be clean’?”
