# *God's Trail For You and Me*

## **Why Can't I Stay On God's Trail?**

*Jeremiah 10:23 (NLT)* I know, LORD, that our lives are not our own. We are not able to plan our own course.

*Proverbs 19:21 (NCV)* People can make all kinds of plans, but only the LORD's plan will happen.

*Psalms 94:11(NLT)* The LORD knows people's thoughts; he knows they are worthless!

*Isaiah 29:15 (NLT)* What sorrow awaits those who try to hide their plans from the LORD, who do their evil deeds in the dark! "The LORD can't see us," they say. "He doesn't know what's going on!"

*Psalms 33:11 (GW)* The LORD's plan stands firm forever. His thoughts stand firm in every generation.

*Proverbs 3:5-6 (NLT)* Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding.

**(6)** Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.

## **How Do I Stay On God's Trail?**

*Romans 8:28 (GW)* We know that all things work together for the good of those who love God—those whom he has called according to his plan.

*Jeremiah 29:11-13 (NIV)* For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. **(12)** Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you.

**(13)** You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.

*Colossians 2:6-8 (NCV)* As you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so continue to live in him. **(7)** Keep your roots deep in him and have your lives built on him. Be strong in the faith, just as you were taught, and always be thankful. **(8)** Be sure that no one leads you away with false and empty teaching that is only human, which comes from the ruling spirits of this world, and not from Christ.

*1 Thessalonians 5:14-22 (GW)* We encourage you, brothers and sisters, to instruct those who are not living right, cheer up those who are discouraged, help the weak, and be patient with everyone. **(15)** Make sure that no one ever pays back one wrong with another wrong. Instead, always try to do what is good for each other and everyone else.

**(16)** Always be joyful. **(17)** Never stop praying. **(18)** Whatever happens, give thanks, because it is God's will in Christ Jesus that you do this. **(19)** Don't put out the Spirit's fire. **(20)** Don't despise what God has revealed. **(21)** Instead, test everything. Hold on to what is good. **(22)** Keep away from every kind of evil.
