Ridin' For The Brand –Up The Galatians Trail

Solid Ground

1. There is only one good trail to follow

Galatians 1:6 (NLT) I am shocked that you are turning away so soon from God, who called you to himself through the loving mercy of Christ. You are following a different way that pretends to be the Good News

2 Corinthians 4:4 (NLT) Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. They are unable to see the glorious light of the Good News.

John 14:4-6 (NLT) ...you know the way to where I am going.” (5) “No, we don't know, Lord,” Thomas said. “We have no idea where you are going, so how can we know the way?” (6) Jesus told him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.

Acts 4:12 (NLT) There is salvation in no one else! God has given no other name under heaven by which we must be saved.”

2. The wrong way is full of twist and turns leading to boggy ground

Galatians 1:7 (NLT) but is not the Good News at all. You are being fooled by those who deliberately twist the truth concerning Christ.

2 Corinthians 11:14-15 (NLT) But I am not surprised! Even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. (15) So it is no wonder that his servants also disguise themselves as servants of righteousness.

Galatians 1:8-9 (NLT) Let God's curse fall on anyone, including us or even an angel from heaven, who preaches a different kind of Good News than the one we preached to you. (9) I say again what we have said before: If anyone preaches any other Good News than the one you welcomed, let that person be cursed.

Acts 17:11 (NLT) the people of Berea were more open-minded than those in Thessalonica, and they listened eagerly to Paul's message. They searched the Scriptures day after day to see if Paul and Silas were teaching the truth.

3. No matter how scenic the trail only the good trail leads to life

Galatians 1:10 (NLT) Obviously, I'm not trying to win the approval of people, but of God. If pleasing people were my goal, I would not be Christ's servant.

Acts 20:20-21 (NLT) I never shrank back from telling you what you needed to hear, either publicly or in your homes. (21) I have had one message for Jews and Greeks alike—the necessity of repenting from sin and turning to God, and of having faith in our Lord Jesus.

Ephesians 2:8-9 (NLT) God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. (9) Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it.
