Last week: Passion & dedication, recognizing I need help, It requires faith on my part

1. How do I hear from God? Start in His _____ Word _____

Deuteronomy 32:1-2 Listen, O heavens, and I will speak! Hear, O earth, the words that I say! **(2)** Let my teaching fall on you like rain; let my speech settle like dew. Let my words fall like rain on tender grass, like gentle showers on young plants.

Ephesians 6:17 "... the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God"

Mark 7:9,13 You skillfully sidestep God's law in order to hold on to your own tradition... And so you cancel the word of God in order to hand down your own tradition.

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires

2. Is that all there is to it? Ask God for _____ direction

Psalm 4:3 You can be sure of this: The LORD set apart the godly for himself. The LORD will answer when I call to him.

James 5:16...The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.

Romans 8:26-27 (Message Bible) Meanwhile, the moment we get tired in the waiting, God's Spirit is right alongside helping us along. If we don't know how or what to pray, it doesn't matter. He does our praying in and for us, making prayer out of our wordless sighs, our aching groans. **(27)** He knows us far better than we know ourselves, knows our pregnant condition, and keeps us present before God.

3. How can I know for sure? Surround yourself with _____ His assistant coaches

2 Timothy 2:1-2 Timothy, my dear son, be strong through the grace that God gives you in Christ Jesus. **(2)**You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses. Now teach these truths to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 (Amplified Bible) Therefore encourage (admonish, exhort) one another and edify (strengthen and build up) one another.
