

Living Thankfully

1. Living thankfully I can praise God for His promises

1 Peter 1:3-5(NIV) Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, (4) and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade--kept in heaven for you, (5) who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time.

John 6:35,37-40 (NIV) "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty...(37) All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away. (38)For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me. (39)And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all that he has given me, but raise them up at the last day. (40)For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day."

2. Living thankfully I can share God's Compassion

Psalms 116:5-6, 12-14 (NIV) The LORD is gracious and righteous; our God is full of compassion. (6) The LORD protects the simple-hearted; when I was in great need, he saved me...(12) How can I repay the LORD for all his goodness to me? (13) I will lift up the cup of salvation and call on the name of the LORD. (14) I will fulfill my vows to the LORD in the presence of all his people.

2 Corinthians 1:3-4 (NIV) Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, (4) who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God.

3. Living thankfully I will be an encouragement to others

Hebrews 10:23-25 (NIV) Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. (24) And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. (25) Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another--and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

2 Corinthians 2:14-16 (GW) But I thank God, who always leads us in victory because of Christ. Wherever we go, God uses us to make clear what it means to know Christ. It's like a fragrance that fills the air. (15)To God we are the aroma of Christ among those who are saved and among those who are dying. (16) To some people we are a deadly fragrance, while to others we are a life-giving fragrance.

Philippians 1:3-6 (NIV) I thank my God every time I remember you. (4) In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy (5) because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, (6) being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
