# Fixin' The Fence/ Bringin' The Jumpers Back To God's Pasture

## 1. Get ready for the work God has called us to do.

*1 John 5:16-17* If you see a Christian brother or sister sinning in a way that does not lead to death, you should pray, and God will give that person life. But there is a sin that leads to death, and I am not saying you should pray for those who commit it. *(17)* All wicked actions are sin, but not every sin leads to death.

*Ephesians 1:16-18* I have not stopped thanking God for you. I pray for you constantly, *(17)* asking God, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, to give you spiritual wisdom and insight so that you might grow in your knowledge of God. *(18)* I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope he has given to those he called—his holy people who are his rich and glorious inheritance.

*Ephesians 3:16-18* I pray that from his glorious, unlimited resources he will empower you with inner strength through his Spirit. *(17)* Then Christ will make his home in your hearts as you trust in him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong. *(18)* And may you have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is. *(19)* May you experience the love of Christ...

## 2. Get the gloves and fence tools out and go to work, God guiding you.

*Galatians 6:1* Dear brothers and sisters, if another believer is overcome by some sin, you who are godly should gently and humbly help that person back onto the right path. And be careful not to fall into the same temptation yourself. *(2)* Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ. *(3)* If you think you are too important to help someone, you are only fooling yourself.

*Matthew 18:15 (GW)* "If a believer does something wrong, go, confront him when the two of you are alone. If he listens to you, you have won back that believer. *(16)* But if he does not listen, take one or two others with you so that every accusation may be verified by two or three witnesses. *(17)* If he ignores these witnesses, tell it to the community of believers. If he also ignores the community, deal with him as you would a heathen or a tax collector. *(18)* I can guarantee this truth: Whatever you imprison, God will imprison. And whatever you set free, God will set free.

## 3. Bring the fence jumper back to God's pasture

*2 Corinthians 2:5-9 (Message)* Now, regarding the one who started all this—the person in question who caused all this pain—I want you to know that I am not the one injured in this as much as, with a few exceptions, all of you. So I don't want to come down too hard. *(6)* What the majority of you agreed to as punishment is punishment enough. *(7)* Now is the time to forgive this man and help him back on his feet. If all you do is pour on the guilt, you could very well drown him in it. *(8)* My counsel now is to pour on the love. *(9)* The focus of my letter wasn't on punishing the offender but on getting you to take responsibility for the health of the church. *(10)* So if you forgive him, I forgive him.

*1 John 1:5-10 (Message)* This, in essence, is the message we heard from Christ and are passing on to you: God is light, pure light; there's not a trace of darkness in him. *(6)* If we claim that we experience a shared life with him and continue to stumble around in the dark, we're obviously lying through our teeth—we're not *living* what we claim. *(7)* But if we walk in the light, God himself being the light, we also experience a shared life with one another, as the sacrificed blood of Jesus, God's Son, purges all our sin.
