1 Corinthians 10:12-13

INTRODUCTION

What are temptations?

- 1. They are not sin but lead to sin if yielded to.
- 2. Temptations are the halfway house between personal desire and personal rebellion.
- 3. They are not to be played with or enticed.
- 4. Temptations often reveal how we want to set up our own Kingdom if we got to be in charge.
- 5. They allow us to see our weaknesses for what they are, and the areas in which we are the most weak.
- 6. Temptations are only a tool of the enemy, but we have a choice whether to use them.
- 7. They can be overcome, but only through God's authority of truth.

1 Corinthians 10:12-13

So, whoever thinks he stands must be careful not to fall. No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to humanity. God is faithful, and He will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation He will also provide a way of escape so that you are able to bear it.
